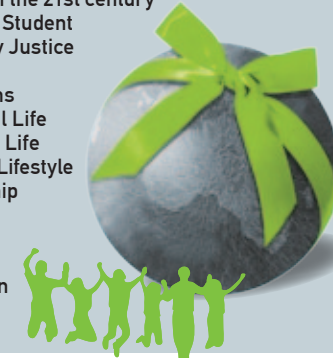

The programme will focus on **local** as well as **global** – and we promise you, it will be very inspiring and challenging!

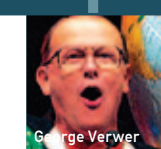

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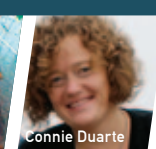
Speakers

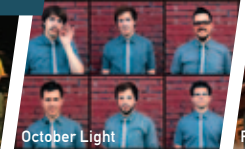


Marcel and Lydia Zimmer (Netherlands) will come with the „World News Band“ and lead us in multicultural worship.
